Schwerpunkte:

Three days of training specializing in the US and Canadian legislation and practice regarding the hazard communication process. The course addresses professionals working with the legislative requirements when marketing chemicals.

Seminarinhalt:

The speakers are EHS-consultants in their country and therefore firm in training people in preparing the Hazard Communication documents.

This three day training is intended to provide the foundation for understanding and complying with the requirements of hazard communication as defined in the legislative mandates of the U.S. and Canada. The workshop on Day 3 deal with the preparing of regulatory compliant labels and MSDS in the Workshops. The participants will work through several examples with the trainer, so that after the course, they will be able to prepare compliant Labels and MSDS.

Day 1 and Day 2

will provide the basis for understanding the U.S. OSHA regulatory requirements governing MSDS preparation and distribution, as well as a firm understanding of MSDS content.

It will provide participants with an intimate knowledge of how to prepare U.S. OSHA compliant Industrial Labels and CPSC compliant Consumer Labels. This part of the course focuses on compliance with regulatory requirements, Industry and ANSI Z129.1-2000 approved practices and how to combine a proper hazard evaluation with the label writing process.
