ENZYMES IN CONSUMER PRODUCTS'**

Enzymes can be used safely in a range of consumer products, provided each use is supported by an accurate risk assessment. This one-day workshop organised by AISE and SDA will focus on current industry best-practice in this area.

The workshop will provide a unique opportunity to gain insights and guidance from a panel of renowned international experts in the area of enzyme safety. It will be of key value to toxicologists, risk assessors and anyone involved in making safety decisions regarding the use of enzymes in consumer products.

The following topics will be discussed:

- Principles of consumer risk assessment for enzyme-containing products, with emphasis on the prevention of respiratory sensitisation.
- Recent advances in the areas of hazard identification and exposure measurements relevant for the endpoint of respiratory sensitisation.
- Practical examples of risk assessments in which the use of enzymes in new product types has been considered.
- Implications of emerging European legislation such as REACH on the risk assessment of products containing enzymes.
- Questions and answers session.
