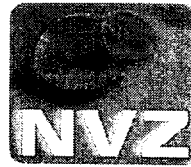

“A Practical Approach to Safe Handling of Enzymes in Industry”

Following on from the successful workshop on Enzyme Safety held in Frankfurt in 2003, A.I.S.E. and NVZ have the pleasure of inviting you to the second event on the same topic, which will take place on: **16 November 2005**

in the Sheraton Schiphol Airport Hotel, Amsterdam the Netherlands.

This one-day workshop will focus on occupational safety of enzymes and should be of real interest to individuals with responsibility for occupational safety or medicine, e.g. site safety technicians, occupational hygienists and health professionals, and other people making decisions on enzyme handling in companies of all sizes.

The workshop is not intended for specialists, but rather for those who have a role in risk management and assuring that the company takes appropriate precautionary measures in enzyme handling. Participation of decision makers from small and medium sized enterprises is encouraged in particular.

In this workshop the participants will learn about best practices of enzyme handling in the soaps, detergents and maintenance products industry. At the end of the session, the participants should have acquired comprehensive information of the safety issues associated with the use of enzymes in manufacturing and of the tools available to minimize the workers exposure including engineering controls, air monitoring and medical surveillance. The participants will have an opportunity to learn from real life case studies and receive feedback from experts how to approach issues that are of specific interest to their company. Furthermore, all of the presentation materials will be available to participants on a CD-ROM.

The workshop speakers are well established experts in enzyme safety in industry. They will bring to the workshop their years of hands on experience in medical issues, safety management, engineering and design features, safe working practices and monitoring.

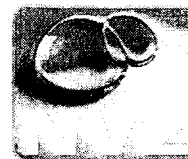
