

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Two-Part Webinar Series: Strategies to Address the Problem of Counterfeit and Gray Market Goods

Government Perspective: Risk Factors Abroad & the Role of Customs in Controlling Risk at the U.S. Borders
Tuesday, September 16, 2008 12:30-2p.m. EDT

In today's global economy, product manufacturing and other functions are routinely outsourced by companies. Along with increased outsourcing, however, comes increased risk, in the form of a greater potential for proliferation of counterfeit and gray market goods. In the first of this two-part webinar, you will hear from a seasoned veteran of the Department of Commerce on the risk factors for the personal care industry and challenges in particular markets, such as China, Brazil, and India. Additionally, the U.S. Customs and Border Protection, now housed within the Department of Homeland Security, has authority over counterfeit goods at the borders. You will hear from the International Trade Specialist, Chris Jackson about ways in which Customs assesses inbound shipments for counterfeit goods, as well as how industry can help the agency better identify and intercept such goods.

Legal Remedies & Best Practices for Brand Protection
Tuesday, October 7, 2008 12:30-2p.m. EDT

Imports at the borders are no longer the sole source of counterfeits and gray market goods. With the increasing popularity of e-commerce sites such as e-Bay and Alibaba, companies are forced to confront the threat of online proliferation of such goods. In this follow-up webinar, companies will learn from legal experts about recent cases involving companies seeking to enforce their trademark rights against online businesses, including the recent Louis Vuitton and Tiffany cases, and against others in the chain of commerce, including credit card and shipping companies. What were the brand owners' obligations? What were the online seller's obligations? This webinar will also review factors to consider when deciding how to bring a legal action. Finally, our speakers will outline corporate best practices to protect one's brand names, including registering and protecting domain names; monitoring online resale sites, trade fairs & discount stores; reviewing trademark applications filed by others; investigating counterfeit sources; recording trademarks with Customs; and supply chain management best practices.
